



Find Ten

A game for 3 to 4 players

You'll need:

Four or more sets of cards

How to play:

- Shuffle the cards.
- 2. Put the stack face down on the table.
- 3. Turn over the first card.
- 4. Player 1 takes the next card.
- 5. If the card on the table and Player 1's card makes 10, Player 1 keeps the cards and gets another turn.
- 6. If they don't make 10, Player 1 puts the card face up on the table and it is Player 2's turn.
- 7. Take turns taking a card and making ten with any card that is on the table.
- 8. If there are two cards on the table that make ten, the next player takes a card, puts it down, and picks up the two cards that make ten. Then that player takes another turn.

Who wins?

When all the cards have been played, the player with the most cards wins.









Teacher Notes:

Students can use 0-10 cards, playing cards with the face cards removed, ten-frame cards, or transition cards with both the ten frame and the numeral on them. If you use playing cards, you might want to use a marker to turn one of the face cards or the joker into a zero.

Students can watch the video which will show them how to play the game.
