



Go Ten

A game for 3 to 4 players

You'll need:

Four or more sets of cards

How to play:

- 1. Shuffle the cards.
- 2. Deal 7 cards to each player. Put the rest of the cards face down in the center of the table.
- 3. Players look at their cards to find pairs that make 10. Players take any pairs they find and put them in their pile.
- 4. Player 1 asks another player for a card that will let them make 10.



This player could ask for a 9, 4, 5, or 8.

- 5. If the player has that card, she has to give it to Player 1. Player 1 takes the two cards and sets them down in his pile. Then Player 1 gets another turn.
 If she doesn't have that card, she says, "Go Fish." Player 1 takes a card from the pile in the center of the table.
- 6. Then it's Player 2's turn.
- 7. Take turns asking for a card to make 10.

Who wins?

When all the cards have been played, the player with the most cards wins.









Teacher Notes:

Students can use 0-10 cards, playing cards with the face cards removed, ten-frame cards, or transition cards with both the ten frame and the numeral on them. If you use playing cards, you might want to use a marker to turn one of the face cards or the joker into a zero.
