



Salute

A game for 3 players

You'll need:

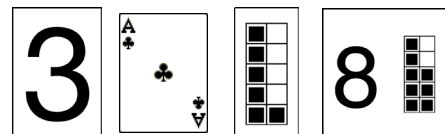
- Four or more sets of cards

How to play:

1. Shuffle the cards and place the pile face down on the table.
2. Player 1 takes the top card and places it near Player 2's forehead so Player 2 can't see it.
3. Player 1 does the same with Player 3. Players 2 and 3 should not know what card they have.
4. Player 1 adds the two numbers and tells the other players the sum.
5. Players 2 and 3 have to look at the other player's card and figure out what is on their card.
6. The first person who says the number on their card gets both cards.

Who wins?

Whoever gets five pairs of cards wins. Switch roles so the player with the fewest (or most) pairs becomes the player who announces the sum.



Teacher Notes:

Students can use 0-10 cards, playing cards with the face cards removed, ten-frame cards, or transition cards with both the ten frame and the numeral on them. If you use playing cards, you might want to use a marker to turn one of the face cards or the joker into a zero.
