



# **Salute**

## A game for 3 players

## You'll need:

Four or more sets of cards

## How to play:

- 1. Shuffle the cards and place the pile face down on the table.
- 2. Player 1 takes the top card and places it near Player 2's forehead so Player 2 can't see it.
- 3. Player 1 does the same with Player 3. Players 2 and 3 should not know what card they have.
- 4. Player 1 adds the two numbers and tells the other players the sum.
- 5. Players 2 and 3 have to look at the other player's card and figure out what is on their card.
- 6. The first person who says the number on their card gets both cards.

### Who wins?

Whoever gets five pairs of cards wins. Switch roles so the player with the fewest (or most) pairs becomes the player who announces the sum.









#### **Teacher Notes:**

Students can use 0-10 cards, playing cards with the face cards removed, ten-frame cards, or transition cards with both the ten frame and the numeral on them. If you use playing cards, you might want to use a marker to turn one of the face cards or the joker into a zero.
