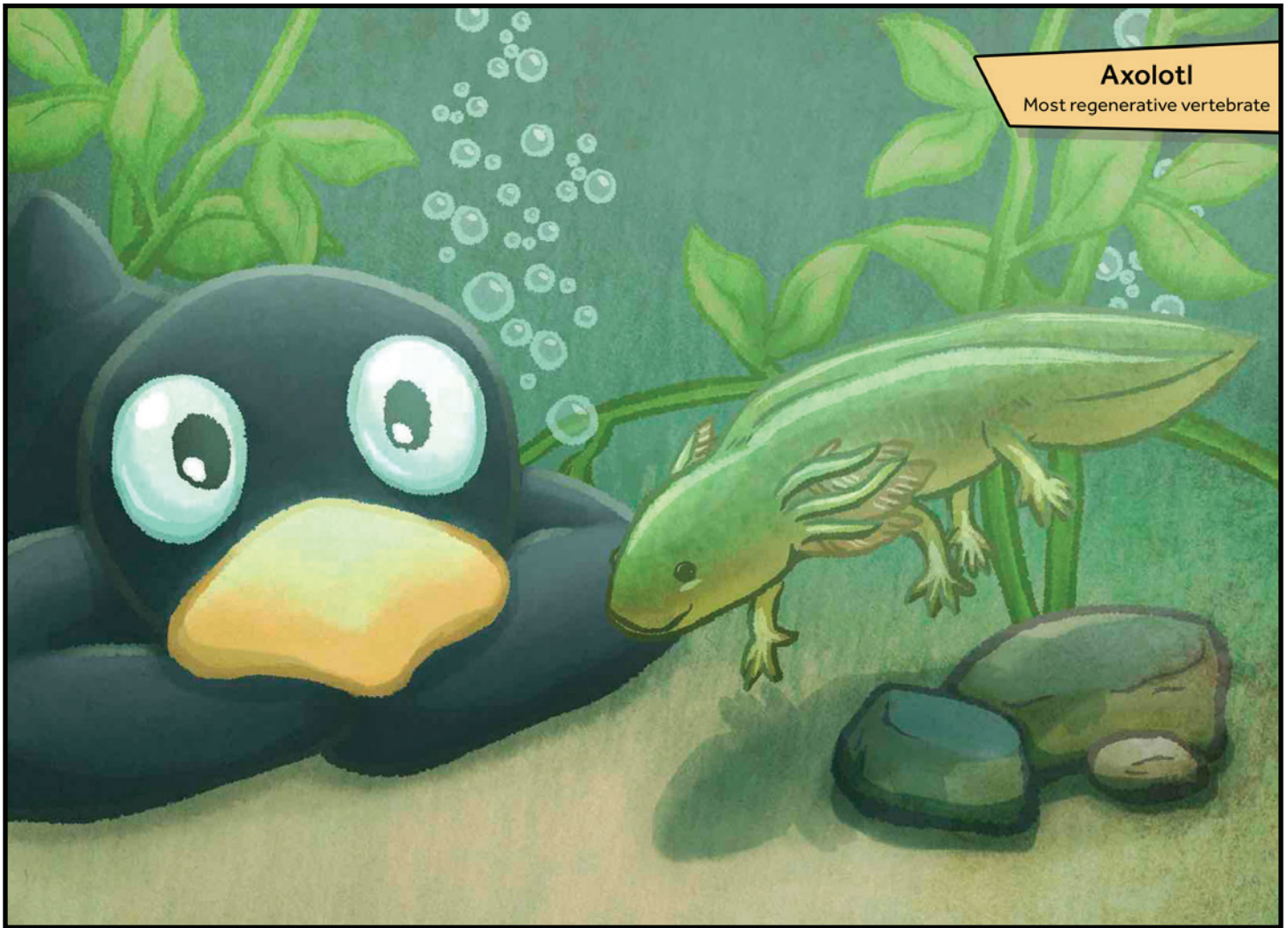

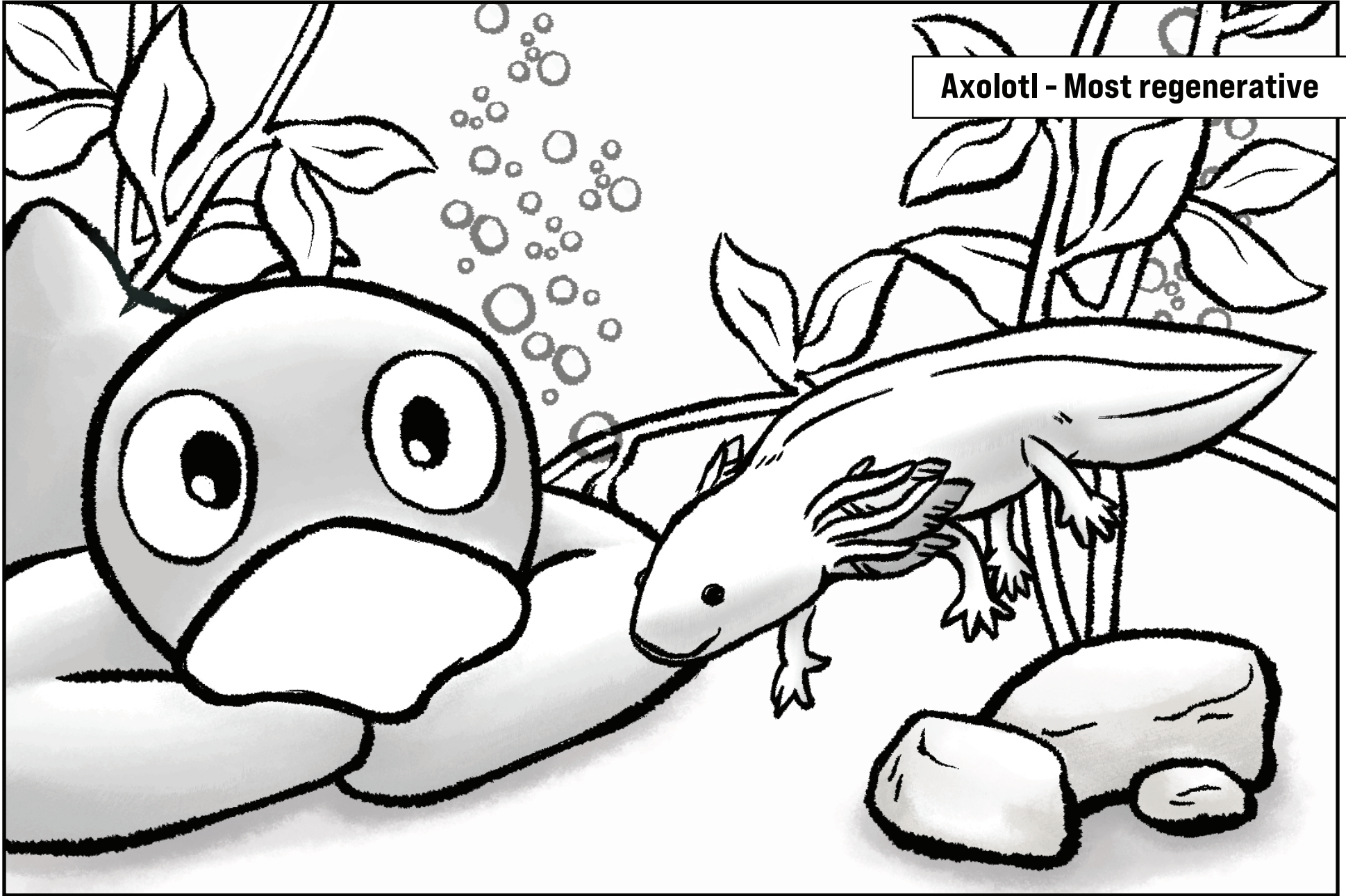

Country/Region	Only in Lake Xochimilco in Mexico
Habitat:	Freshwater lake

DID YOU KNOW?

1. Axolotls have the unique ability to regenerate, or regrow, injured or missing limbs and some other body parts.
2. The word axolotl ("water monster") comes from the Nahuatl language of the Aztec.
3. Axolotls have a huge appetite and will eat almost anything they can fit in their mouths.
