**DID YOU KNOW?**

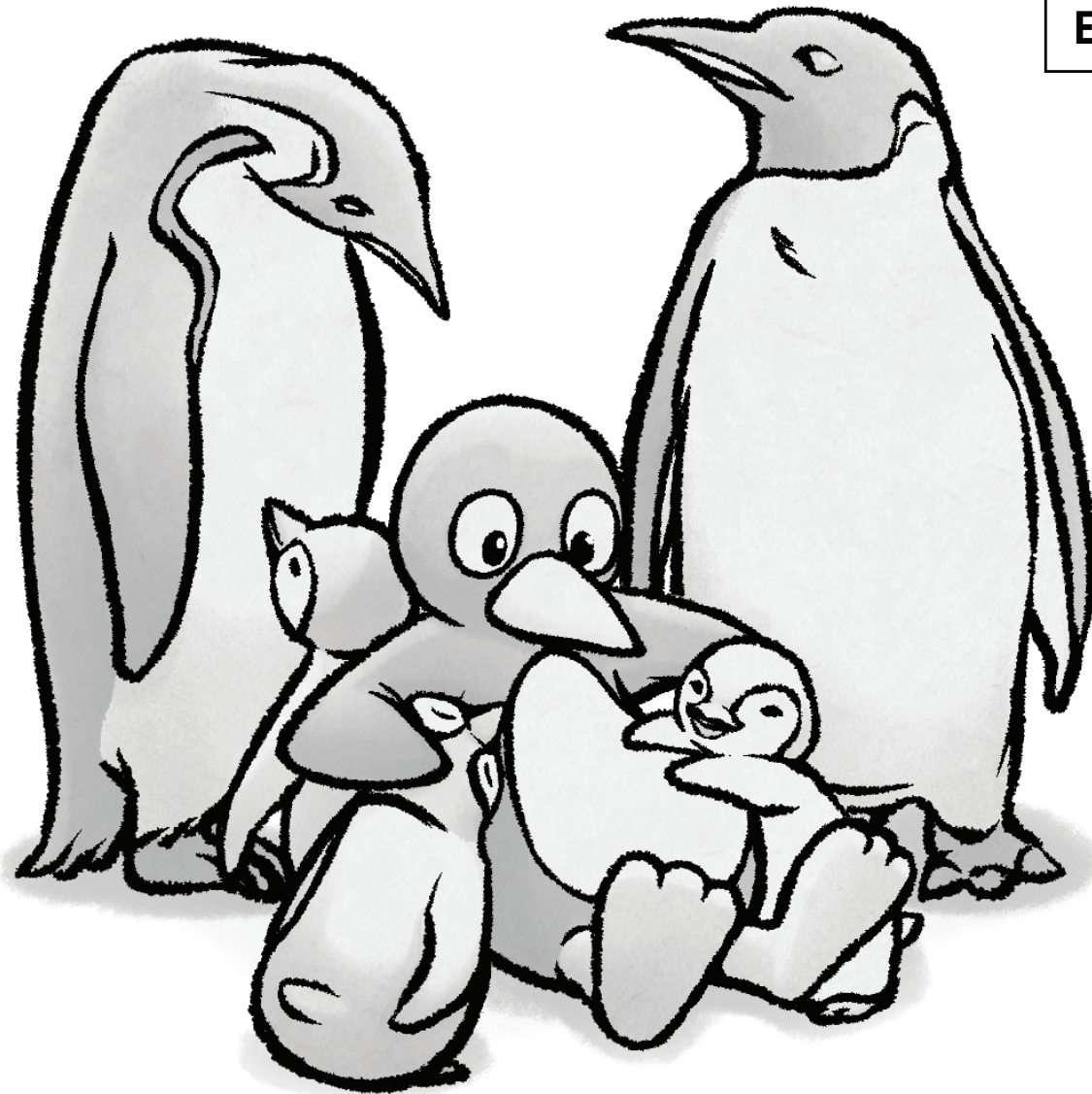
1. Emperor Penguins can dive deeper (1,640 ft, 500 m) and survive longer without eating (4 months) than any other bird.
2. They have large stores of insulating body fat and several layers of scale-like feathers that protect them from icy winds.
3. Scientists use satellites in space to spot new colonies of Emperor penguins.
