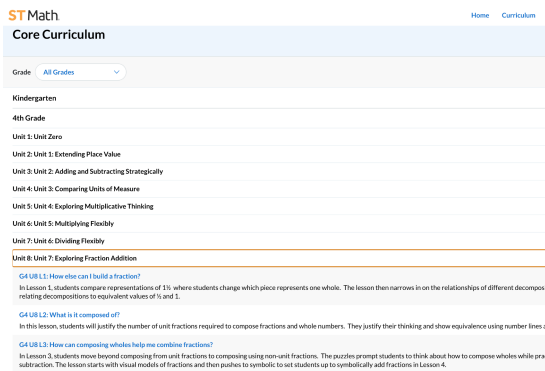
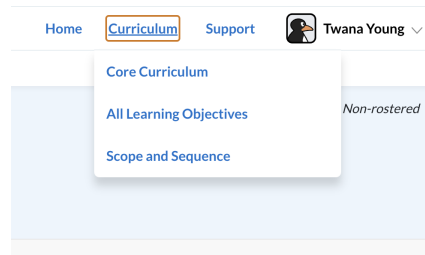


QuickStart Guide

1. **Make sure all students and you as the teacher are signed out of ST Math**
2. Sign-in as an educator to ST Math (InsightMath Test school)

Go to the Curriculum dropdown and select - Core Lessons



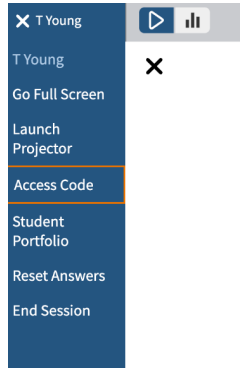
Select grade 4 > Unit 8:Unit7 (Exploring Fraction Addition) > appropriate lesson

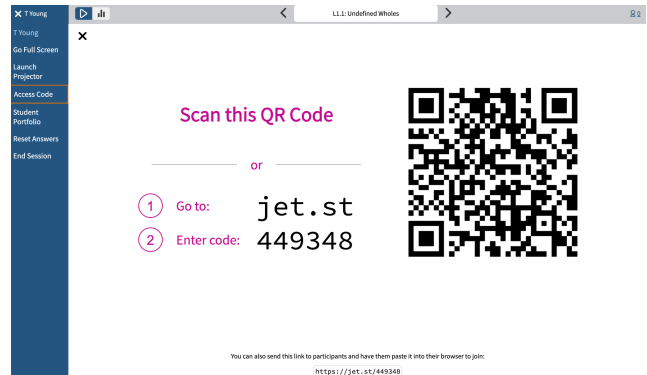
Start the lesson by clicking on the “Start Demo Lesson” button - this will open the lesson in a new browser tab.





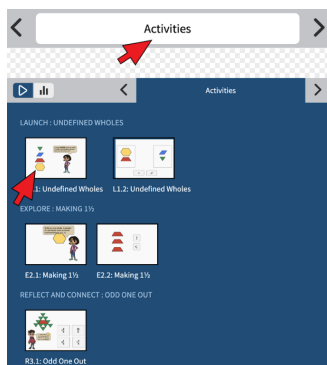
Click on your name in the top left corner to see the lesson menu choices in the toolbar.

Click on "Access code"



Have students type *jet.st* in their browser (Google Chrome works best) and enter the 6-digit access code. **(Students must be logged out of ST Math when they sign in, otherwise they will not be able to sign in.)**

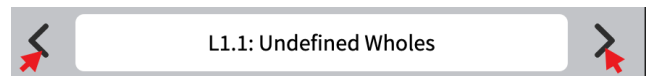
Teacher Tip: Write *jet.st* and the code on the board for later reference. This will come in handy if students get logged out and in to log back in.



To start the first activity, you will need to click in the white bar. You will see the activities in the lesson. Click on the first one to begin.

Teacher Tip: Clicking on the white bar at any point during the lesson will return you to this lesson outline. This will allow you to move to any activity you wish to show.

To advance through the activities you need to click on the arrow button. The right button will



move the lesson forward and the left button will move the lesson back.

To view student work



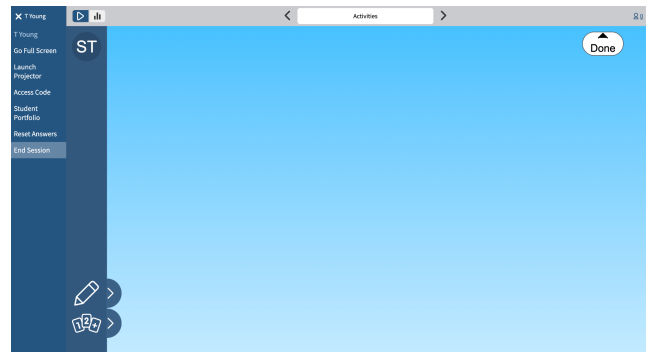
Click on the graph at the top left hand side to see submitted student work. Please be aware students will be able to see this screen unless you are able to stop projecting while you look at student work.

Use the table or grid (shown) view.

Click on a piece of student work to bring it up and show the class for discussion.

Note: The student name will show on the screen when you share it. There will be an option in later versions to hide student names.

After each lesson is complete, make sure to sign out of the lesson by clicking “End Session” in the left side toolbar menu. Otherwise, you won’t be able to start a new one.



Troubleshooting

- If the screen freezes or does not look right - click the refresh button on your browser.
- If that does not work try signing in and out.
